BE IT REMEMBERED THE HONORABLE BOARD OF QUAY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS met in regular session the 23rd day of March, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. at the Nara Visa, New Mexico Community Center, for the purpose of taking care of any business that may come before them.

Chairman Franklin McCasland called the meeting to order. Thomas Garcia led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman McCasland requested a correction be made in the Minutes regarding Brad Bryant's name being on them as Chairman. Ellen White said the copies for signatures appear to be correct. It was noted the corrections had not be sent to the Manager's Office before packets were distributed to the Commission. A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to approve the minutes from the March 9, 2015 regular session as printed. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", McCasland voting "aye", and Dowell voting "aye".

A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry SECONDED by Sue Dowell to approve the Agenda as presented. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye", McCasland voting "aye".

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Chairman McCasland welcomed the Nara Visa residents.

ONGOING BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

Becky Wallace, Quay County Family Health Center Administrator requested approval of 2014-2015 Resolution No. 32 authorizing submission of the NM Department of Health RPHCA Funding Application for the Primary Care Clinic of Quay County. Wallace also provided an update regarding their Provider status reporting LaDonna Chacon is now employed and they have hired a second Nurse Practitioner that will arrive in May. Meanwhile a local provider is assisting until May. A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to approve Resolution No. 32. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", McCasland voting "aye" and Dowell voting "aye". A copy of said Resolution and Application is attached and made a part of these minutes.

Donald Adams, Quay County Fire Marshall requested approval of the following items:

1. Volunteer Fire Fighters PERA Service Certifications for Rural 1, Rural 2, Rural 3, Bard, Forrest, Jordan, Porter and Quay. Commissioner Cherry noted that all the activity boxes were not complete on the report for Rural 1. Adams said he would make a note and ask them to make sure they are completed. A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to approve all reports. MOTION carried with Dowell voting "aye", Cherry voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye". Copies are attached and made a part of these minutes.
2. Bid Award for Rural 1 Fire Department for Initial Attack Fire Vehicle. Adams stated only one bid was received from Steele Fire Apparatus with a total amount of \$167,419.00. A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to approve the Bid from Steele Fire Apparatus. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", McCasland voting "aye" and Dowell voting "aye".
3. Donation of 1985 Ford F-250 4x4 and 1985 Chevrolet 4x4 from Dexter Fire and Rescue. Adams said James Salas, Assistant Executive Chief of Dexter will be requesting approval from his Board of Commissioners to make this donation but does not anticipate any problems. A MOTION was made by Sue Dowell, SECONDED by Mike Cherry to approve accepting the donation pending the approval from the Dexter Board of Commissioners. MOTION carried with Dowell voting "aye", Cherry voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye".

Vic Baum, Quay County Assessor presented the 2015 Annual Report of Assessments for Quay County. A MOTION was made by Sue Dowell, SECONDED by Mike Cherry to approve the Report. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye". Copy is attached and made a part of these minutes.

Curtis Simpson, Quay County Emergency Management Coordinator, requested approval of 2015-2016 Mitigation Sub-Grant Application. Simpson said this Grant is for \$45,000 with a 25% match from the County. This Planning Grant will be used to update the Quay County Hazard Mitigation Plan. A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to approve the Application. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye". A copy is attached and made a part of these minutes.

Ellen White, County Clerk Chief Deputy provided the following items for information from the Clerk's Office:

1. Third and final 2015 Occupation License Notices. White stated only 7 of the 82 County Businesses are unpaid at this time.

2. Reported the County had been reimbursed \$1,792.42 for the 2014 General Election Recount.
3. Reported the costs of the recently conducted School Board and Mesalands Elections.
4. Provided the minutes from the Board of Registration from the Purge of Inactive Voters from Quay County held on March 9.

Larry Moore, Quay County Road Superintendent gave the following report:

1. Requested approval of Resolution No. 31 regarding the 2015 Certified County Maintained Mileage Report and supporting map. A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to approve said Resolution. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye". A copy is attached to these minutes and on file in the County Clerk's Office.
2. Informed the Board the Match Waiver for the CAP and COOP project (Quay Road 63) has been received.
3. The three Environmental clearances for the Quay Road 63 project have also been received and the project can move forward. Engineers Inc. has been notified to proceed with the Bid Process.
4. Crews have hauled 2 miles on Quay Road U from the materials stock piled and have 1.6 miles remaining. The hauling should be complete next week.
5. The New Mexico Transmission Commission held their meeting in Tucumcari on March 18-19 at the Convention Center. Moore reported the event was well attended.
6. The Legislative Bill to have speed limits on rural roads at 55 mph unless otherwise posted has passed both Houses and has been sent to the Governor.
7. Blades have been running with the recent moisture with focus on problem areas.

Manager, Richard Primrose informed Moore that the Village of House is requesting assistance with some roads in the Village as they have no equipment to blade. Moore will contact Sherman Martin.

Primrose also thanked Larry Moore, Bob McClelland, Jr. and Ronny Sanders for preparing the dinner for the Transportation Commission Meeting.

Commissioner Dowell asked Moore if potholes were being repaired on roadways. Moore said they were addressing those in priority of roadways.

Richard Primrose, Quay County Manager presented the following items:

1. Primrose, along with Commissioners Cherry and McCasland attended the Land Use Workshop held in Grady. Chairman McCasland stated the goal of the group, along with Quay County and a variety of entities including Arch Hurley Conservancy District and the Canadian River Soil and Conservation District, is to protect the lands from the random Endangered Species Acts. Updating the plan will assist with protection of lands in Quay County because the Environmental groups pushing the Endangered Acts have to address Land Use Plans prior to labeling areas with an endangered status. McCasland stated it could very well be a cost shared update of the current Land Use Plan regarding the Professional Services.
2. Requested approval of the quarterly payment to Trigg Memorial Hospital from the Mill Levy and Gross Receipts Tax. The amount of the payment is \$315,000.00. A MOTION was made by Sue Dowell, SECONDED by Mike Cherry to approve said payment. MOTION carried with Dowell voting "aye", Cherry voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye".

Managers Correspondence:

1. Presented the monthly Gross Receipts Tax Report for March. Primrose stated this was the lowest report during his time as Manager.
2. Roof at the Detention Center is complete except for the installation of razor wire which should be complete tomorrow.
3. The new ADA Accessible parking and entry is being built on the Northside of the Courthouse. Chairman McCasland thanked Primrose for seeing this much needed project through.
4. Reported the draft of the 40 Year Water Plan is scheduled to be approved by the Finance Authority at their meeting and then will be forwarded to Interstate Stream Commission for their approval.

A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to go into the Indigent Claims Board. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye". TIME NOTED 9:50 a.m.

Return to Regular Session. Time noted 12:15 p.m.

A MOTION was made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell that only the items mentioned above regarding Executive Session were discussed and no action was taken. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye".

Chairman McCasland requested the Commissioners decision regarding action of a proposed Tolling Agreement with Acting Receiver of Ute Lake Ranch Inc./DVR LLC. A MOTION was

made by Mike Cherry, SECONDED by Sue Dowell to table any action on the Tolling Agreement. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye".

McCasland requested action regarding the Letter of Resignation from Quay County Treasurer Nadine Angel. Commissioner Dowell made the MOTION to accept the Letter of Resignation from Nadine Angel. Dowell expressed the Commission's appreciation for her years and years of commitment and the job she has done for the County. Commissioner Cherry SECONDED the MOTION. MOTION carried with Cherry voting "aye", Dowell voting "aye" and McCasland voting "aye".

Chairman McCasland requested the Boards approval of the Public Notice regarding the vacancy of Quay County Treasurer. Commissioner Cherry made a MOTION, SECONDED by Chairman McCasland to approve the Public Notice with the deletion of the second sentence in the first paragraph. Chairman McCasland called for further discussion.

Commissioner Dowell stated she believes that when anyone looks at hiring someone else, that the use of providing references, whether it's personal or business references from other places they have worked is important. Dowell would rather see the three references be included to someone where they are going to look at appointing them to the position of County Treasurer.

Commissioner Cherry said he would remove his Motion if Chairman McCasland would agree to remove the SECOND.

Chairman McCasland commented the notice is requesting a full resume and letter of interest. If someone is really serious about the position, letters of reference will be provided. McCasland said the Board is paying for this advertisement and the extra wording is not worth the additional cost.

Commissioner Cherry called for the QUESTION. Chairman McCasland called for a vote. Cherry voted "aye"; McCasland voted "aye"; Dowell asked for clarification of what the vote is on. Commissioner McCasland stated the vote is regarding the original MOTION made by Commissioner Cherry. Dowell voted "NO". MOTION carried with Cherry and McCasland voting "YES" and Dowell voting "NO".

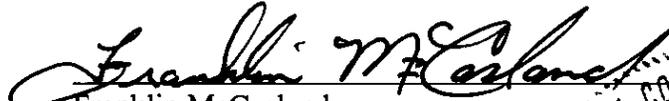

Chairman McCasland thanked Renee Rinstine for her hospitality in hosting the Quay County Board of Commission meeting today.

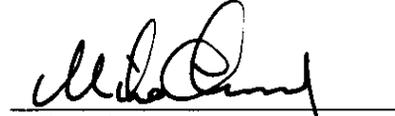

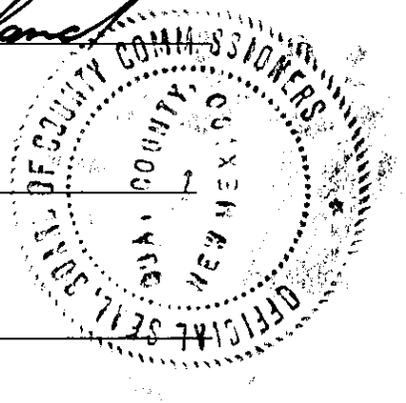

Whereas, a program was established to make grant and distribution funding available to counties and municipalities for offsetting the medical costs of the sliding fee scale patients; and

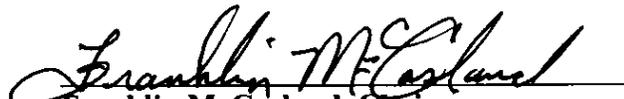
Whereas, the Primary Care Clinic of Quay County and other agencies approval must be received in order to apply for grant and distribution funding; and

Grant Terms and Conditions (continued from Section 10 of Award)

(A) Scope of Work: Quay County has been awarded funds to up-date the Quay County Mitigation Plan. Funds shall be utilized as outlined in the approved budget as awarded by FEMA on January 7, 2015.

(B) Changes to Award: All change requests must be submitted in writing, or electronically to the DHSEM grant specialist, accompanied by a justification narrative and budget/spending plan, for review and approval. Changes must be consistent with the scope of the project and grant guidelines. Requests for changes will be considered only if the reporting requirements are current, and if terms and conditions have been met at the time the request. Changes in the programmatic activities, or purpose of the project, changes in key persons specified on the grant award, contractual services for activities central to the purposes of the award, requests for additional funding, change in project site, or release of special conditions will result in an amendment to this award.

(C) Reimbursements: Submit a *Request for Reimbursement* along with the *Financial Progress Report* form. Reimbursement shall be based upon authorized and allowable expenditures consistent with project narrative and grant guidelines, and submission of timely quarterly *Narrative* and *Financial Progress Reports*. Payments may be withheld pending correction of deficiencies. Reimbursement of expenditures may be requested at any time within the performance period so long as reports are current. Expenditures must be supported with source documentation (e.g. copies of invoices, receipts, timesheets with name/wage/hours, cost allocation, warrants, etc.).

- **Personnel Costs:** Payroll reports signed and certified by the chief financial officer that capture the employee name, position, coded allocation to the project, amount paid, are acceptable. Staff may not self-certify their own time and wages. **QUAY COUNTY** shall retain all supporting payroll records, including time and attendance records signed by the employee and supervisor and copies of warrants as per the recordkeeping requirements in Section 1.J.
- **Contracts:** All sole-source procurements, single vendor response to a competitive bid, and contracts require DHSEM pre-approval prior to implementation. Copies of all contracts required for submission to DHSEM with the request for reimbursement.
- **Local Match:** Local matching funds must clearly support the source, the amount, and the timing of all matching contributions.

(D) Non-reimbursable Expenses:

- Transfer of funds between any programs
- Contracts, single vendor response to a competitive bid, and procurements > \$100,000 not pre-approved by DHSEM
- Sole source contracts and procurements not pre-approved by DHSEM
- Training and related travel costs not pre-approved by DHSEM
- Construction and renovation
- Indirect costs (p. 5, Financial Progress Report)
- Supplanting (using federal funds to purchase items previously budgeted for with state or local funds)
- Maintenance and/or wear and tear costs of general use vehicles and emergency response apparatus.
- Equipment purchased for an exercise cannot be used for permanent installation and/or beyond the scope of an exercise.
- Hiring of sworn public safety officers to fill traditional public safety duties or to supplant traditional public safety positions and responsibilities
- Weapons and ammunition
- Entertainment and sporting events
- Personal items such as laundry, personal hygiene items, magazines, in-room movies, personal travel
- Travel insurance, visa, and passport charges
- Lodging costs in excess of Federal or State per diem, as appropriate
- Lunch when travel is wholly within a single day

- Organized fund-raising, including salaries of persons while engaged in these activities

- Expenditures not supported with appropriate documentation when submitted for reimbursement. Only properly documented expenditures will be processed for payment. Unsupported expenditures will be returned to the jurisdiction for resubmission.

(E) Procurement: Procurement shall comply with local procurement policies and procedures, and conform to applicable State and Federal law and the standards identified in the Procurement Standards Sections of *28 CFR Parts 66 and 70*, and *OMB Circular A-102 "Uniform Administrative Requirements for Grants and Cooperative Agreements with State and Local Governments."* Contractors that develop or draft specifications, requirements, Statements of Work, and/or Requests for Proposals (RFP) for a proposed procurement shall be excluded from bidding or submitting a proposal to compete for the award of such procurement. Local bidder's preference is not allowed for federally funded procurements. Procurement transactions shall be conducted to provide maximum open and free competition. **Each sole-source procurement, single vendor response to a competitive bid, and all purchases require prior approval of DHSEM.** DHSEM has provided a summary of documentation required for levels of procurement and attached it to the instructions on the quarterly *Financial Progress Reports*.

(F) Contracts: Any contract entered into during this grant period shall comply with local, State and Federal government contracting regulations. Contracts for professional and consultant services must include local, State and Federal government required contract language, a project budget, and require pre-approval by DHSEM prior to implementation. Contract deliverables must meet the intent of the grant application and grant requirements. Justification is required for compensation for individual consultant services, which must be reasonable and consistent with the amount paid for similar services in the market place. Detailed invoices, and time and effort reports are required for consultants. A summary of documentation required for levels of contracting is attached to the instructions on the quarterly *Financial Progress Reports*.

(G) Publications: Publications created with funding under this grant shall prominently contain the following statement: *This Document was prepared under a sub-grant from the FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, and the NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. Points of view or opinions expressed in this document are those of the authors and do not necessarily represent the official position or policies of the Federal Emergency Management Agency of New Mexico Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.*

(H) Audit Requirements: As the Federal grant recipient, the State of New Mexico requires a sub-recipient **expending \$500,000** or more in total Federal funds in the organization's fiscal year to conduct an organization-wide audit in accordance with *OMB Circular A-133*. **QUAY COUNTY** will permit the State of New Mexico Grant and Program officials and auditors to have access to the sub-recipient's and third-party contractors' records and financial statements as necessary for the State of New Mexico to comply with *OMB Circular A-133*. Copies of audit findings must be submitted to DHSEM within 30 days after the County receives its audit report, or within a 9-month period of the grant closeout date, whichever is earlier, in accordance with *2 AAC 45.010*. Include the Federal agency name, program, grant number, and year; the CFDA title and number; and the name of the pass-through agency.

(I) Recordkeeping Requirements: Grant financial and administrative records shall be maintained for a period of three (3) years following the date of the closure of the grant award, or audit if required. Time and effort, personnel and payroll records for all individuals reimbursed under the award must be maintained. Property and equipment records shall be maintained for a period of three (3) years following the final disposition, replacement or transfer of the property and equipment.

(J) Performance Measures/Reporting: Quarterly Performance and Financial Reports shall demonstrate performance and progress relative to:

1. Acceptable performance on applicable critical tasks in Exercises using approved scenarios
2. Progress in achieving project timelines and milestones
3. Percent measurable progress toward completion of project
4. How funds have been expended during reporting period, and explains expenditures related to the project

Reports are due on 10/30, 1/30, 4/30, and 7/30 for each calendar year the award is open.

(K) Sub-recipient Monitoring Policy: Periodic monitoring is required to ensure that program goals, objectives, timelines, budgets and other related program criteria are being met. DHSEM reserves the right to periodically monitor, review and conduct analysis of the financial, programmatic and administrative policies and procedures such as, accounting for receipts and expenditures, cash management, maintaining adequate financial records, means of allocating and tracking costs, contracting and procurement policies and records, payroll records and means of allocating staff costs, property/equipment management system(s), progress of project activities, etc. This may include desk and field audits. (L) Penalty for Non-Compliance: For the reasons listed below, special conditions may be imposed, reimbursements may be partially or wholly withheld, the award may be wholly or partly suspended or terminated, or future awards, reimbursements and award modifications may be withheld. DHSEM may institute the following, but is not limited to, withholding authority to proceed to the next phase of a project, requiring additional or more detailed financial reports, additional project monitoring, and/or establish additional prior approvals. DHSEM shall notify the County of its decision in writing stating the nature and the reason for imposing the conditions/restrictions, the corrective action required and timeline to remove them, and the method of requesting reconsideration of the imposed conditions/restrictions. The County must respond within 5 days of receipt of notification.

- a. Unwillingness or inability to attain project goals

(M) Termination for Cause: If performance is not occurring as agreed, the award may be reduced or terminated without compensation for reduction or termination costs. DHSEM will provide 5 days notice to **QUAY COUNTY** stating the reasons for the action, steps taken to correct the problems, and the commencement date of the reduction or termination. DHSEM will reimburse **QUAY COUNTY** only for acceptable work or deliverables, necessary and allowable costs incurred through the date of reduction or termination. Final payment may be withheld at the discretion of DHSEM until completion of a final DHSEM review. Any equipment purchased under a terminated grant may revert to DHSEM at the option of DHSEM.

(N) Termination for Convenience: Any project may be terminated upon convenience, in whole or in part, for the convenience of the Government. The Federal Emergency Management Agency and the DHSEM, by written notice, may terminate this grant, in whole or in part, when it is in the Government's interest. Allowable costs obligated and/or incurred through the date of termination shall be reimbursed. Any equipment purchased under a terminated grant may revert to DHSEM at the option of DHSEM.

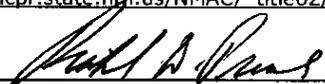

Grant Requirements, Assurances and Agreements (continued from Section 11 of the Award)

- (A) The performance period for this grant award is January 7, 2015 through January 7, 2017. Monies may not be obligated outside of this time period. An obligation occurs when funds are encumbered, as with a purchase order and/or commitment of salaries and benefits. All obligated and encumbered funds must be liquidated within 45 days of the end of the performance period when the *Final Progress Reports* are due.
- (B) The signature of the signatory officials on this award certifies that all financial expenditures, including all supporting documentation submitted for reimbursement, have been incurred by the jurisdiction, and are eligible and allowable expenditures consistent with the grant guidelines for this project. **QUAY COUNTY** shall follow the financial management requirements imposed on them by DHSEM, which includes the requirements of federal Emergency Management Agency.
- (C) The signature of the signatory officials on this award attests to **QUAY COUNTY** understanding, acceptance, and compliance with **Lobbying; Debarment, Suspension and other responsibility matters; Drug-free Workplace; Conflict of Interest, and Non-Supplanting certifications.** Federal funds will not be used to supplant State or local funds. - (F) **QUAY COUNTY** certifies that it has an Affirmative Action Plan/Equal Employment Opportunity Plan (for USDHS/DOJ grants). An EEO is not required for recipients of less than \$25,000.00 or fewer than 50 employees.

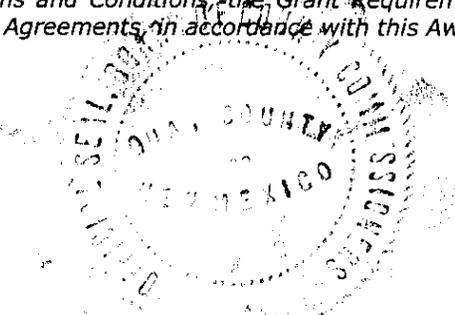

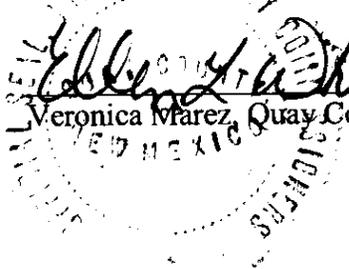
