Public Comments:

Mike Whitesides, resident at 6253 Quay Road AL, thanked the Road Department for recent work on that roadway, but asked them for additional work closer to his residence.

NEW BUSINESS:

In the absence of Renee Hayoz, Quay County Family Health Center Administrator, Zamora presented the April RPHCA Report, which is attached to these minutes. County Manager, Daniel Zamora presented the invoice from the Quay County Family Health Center totaling \$7,530.20 for their RPHCA funding. A

MOTION was made by Jerri Rush, SECONDED by Brian Fortner to approve. MOTION carried with all members voting "aye". A copy is attached.

In the absence of Quay County Road Superintendent, Stephen Salas, Zamora presented the following item for approval and gave the Road Department report:

- Resolution No. 43; Match Commitment for Phase 2 Construction in the amount of \$146,097.71 on Quay Road 63. A MOTION was made by Brian Fortner, SECONDED by Jerri Rush to approve Resolution No. 43. MOTION carried with all members voting "aye". A copy is attached.
- Resolution No. 44; Match Commitment for Phase 1 Planning and Design in the amount of \$16,413.15 for Quay Road AR. A MOTION was made by Jerri Rush, SECONDED by Brian Fortner to approve Resolution No. 44. MOTION carried with all members voting "aye". A copy is attached.
- Blade Reports were distributed.
- Crews will be micro-sealing Quay Road AI in the next week, along with installing the flashing stop sign at the railroad crossing. Speed limit signs have also been installed in both directions.
- Crews will be micro-sealing a portion of Evans Street in the next couple of weeks.
- Destruction and Clean-up has started on the collapsed bridge on Route 66.

Quay County Sheriff, Dennis Garcia presented the Incident Report for the Sheriff's Office. A copy is attached to these minutes.

Quay County DWI Coordinator, Rico Marano presented the 3rd Quarterly Report of the DWI Programs. A copy is attached. Marano stated he recently attended a meeting and was notified by DFA the funds for the FY25 year are approved. Marano thanked the Manager's Office for submission of timely and accurate reports to DFA on behalf of his office, which is an asset when applying for yearly funds.

Quay County Manager, Daniel Zamora provided information to the Commissioners for the upcoming budget regarding the cost-of-living increases for employees. Zamora reported both options of \$1 and \$2 per hour were discussed and he is certain the \$2 increase is justified and within the budget. The Commissioners concurred and asked him to move forward with that for the next meeting and approval of the budget.

Samanta Salas, Quay County Finance Director, requested approval of the following items:

- Resolution No. 46; Budgetary Increase to Environmental Gross Receipts in the amount of \$20,000.00.
